Course Content

The main qualification is the Diploma NVQ 2 / 3 in Body and Paint Operations, gained in the workplace. The Apprentice will build a portfolio of proof of competence, comprising of witness testimony, photographs, direct observation and oral questioning.

On their day release they will be studying the Diploma in Body and Paint Operations which comprises of theory and practical sessions.

Apprentices will work towards achieving Functional Skills in English, ICT and Maths.

Course duration and format

Normally 2 year for Level 2 dependent on prior knowledge and experience. One year for level 3. The Apprentice will spend 4 days in the workplace and attend College 1 day per week.
