- // Level 2 Functional Skills in Maths and English

### Course Content

The Certificate and Diploma qualifications are delivered in the workplace. Maths and English Functional Skills are delivered in college. The Apprentices will build a portfolio of their work, the evidence for which will be gathered via witness testimonies, written assignments, direct observations and oral questioning.

### Course duration and format

1 year to complete for Level 2 and 3, dependent on the candidate's prior knowledge and experience.
