Plumbing & Heating

Areas covered

- // Understand and carry out safe working practices in building services engineering
- // Understand how to communicate with others within Building Services engineering
- // Understand how to apply environmental protection measures within BSE
- // Understand how to apply scientific principles within mechanical services engineering
- // Understand and carry out site preparation, and pipe work fabrication techniques for domestic plumbing and heating systems
- // Understand and apply domestic cold / hot water / central heating system installation and maintenance techniques
- // Understand and apply domestic rainwater system / above ground drainage system installation and maintenance techniques
- // Apply safe working practices in building services engineering working environment
- // Install and maintain domestic heating and / or plumbing systems

Course Content

The main qualifications at Level 2 are either the Level 2 NVQ Diploma in Installing and Maintaining Domestic Heating Systems or Level 2 NVQ in Plumbing & Heating. Progression onto NVQ Level 3 Diploma in Domestic Plumbing and Heating or NVQ Level 3 Diploma in Domestic Heating. These are gained in the workplace. The Apprentice will build a portfolio of proof of competence comprising of witness testimony, direct observation, oral question and photo/video evidence. The apprentice will also complete Functional Skills in Maths and English at Level 2 and ICT at Level 1.

Course Duration and format

Each course will run for 2 years. The Apprentice will spend 4 days in the workplace and attend College 1 day per week.
